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2.5.2 - Reforms initiated on Continuous Internal Evaluation(CIE) system at the institutional level (250 words)

To ensure the stakeholders of the institution especially students and faculty aware of the evaluation process the institution takes the following measures. 1. The evaluation methods are communicated through the prospectus, notice board, morning mass prayer and even through announcement in the classroom. 2. The progress of the students is monitored by the teachers through periodical tests, home assignments, group discussion, interactive sessions and preparatory examinations. 3. Irregular and absents students are made regular through letter correspondence and counseling. Evaluation reforms initiated by the university According to Tumkur University rules every student has to secure 75<sup>^</sup> of attendance to appear for the examination. Minimum Internal Assessment marks has been made compulsory for all students to appear for final examination. The university has fixed 180 working days for each semester.

2.5.3 – Academic calendar prepared and adhered for conduct of Examination and other related matters (250 words)

All the Heads of department in consultation with faculty members scheduled an academic calendar before the commencement of the academic session. Every teacher his/her teaching plan taking into consideration the ability of his / her student. These plans are reviewed and re-checked. The academic calendar and individual teaching plans are meant for board reference. Evaluation blue print: Tests are held monthly and at the end of the chapter. Schedule of the college and university examination is given in their prospectus at the beginning of the year has guided by affiliating college.
